The rules govern IT governance by OCIO, rules related to the procurement of IT including rules delegating procurement authority, and rules related to the broadband grant program. The rules are no longer necessary now that OCIO is part of DOM, and any rules needed should be in Chapter 541. A new, more succinct and less burdensome rule will be created in IAC 541 as a replacement.
